RECYCLABLES – Please place all materials together in our clear recycle bags.

Aluminum & Tin Cans

Empty and rinse all food and product containers.

- Aerosol cans (empty, no caps and nonhazardous)
- Aluminum foil, foil trays and band (clean)
- Beverage and soda cans
- Food and soup cans
- Lids and caps (example: from glass bottles, jars)

GLASS

NO GLASS

PAPER

Staples are acceptable.

- Books, magazines and catalogs
- Junk mail and Envelopes
- Newspaper
- Paperboard (example: cereal, cracker, pasta boxes)
- White computer paper

PLASTIC

Empty and rinse all food and product containers.

- Beverage bottles (example: soda, juice, water)
- Food containers (example: cottage cheese, yogurt)
- Squeezable bottles (example: honey, mayo, ketchup)

Plastic **NOT TO BE** place in recycle bag:

- Toys or storage containers
- Shopping bags (often stores may have a collection bin)

CARDBOARD

Boxes must be broken down into recycle bag or Call for possible arrangements.

- Egg cartons (cardboard)
- Shoe boxes
- Moving boxes
